- ❖ **LENDING** is available to applicants who meet income and MBDP guidelines.
- ❖ **FREE** technical assistance to our clients including business plan preparation assistance, research, and cash flow projections.

LOAN PROGRAM

The MBDP has microloans available for businesses that qualify. Loans range from \$500 to \$25,000 and must be for a business located in Jackson County.

- ❖ MBDP Lending Eligibility: applicants must be able to document that they reside in a household with a total household income that is at or below 80% of the Jackson County median

income, adjusted for household size based on the current Section 8 guidelines established by the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

- ❖ Applicants must demonstrate that they are unable to secure a commercial loan or unable to afford a commercial loan at market rates.
- ❖ Applicants must submit completed business plans to our Loan Review Committee and attend relevant business classes.



TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Regardless of lending qualifications, JCEDB offers **FREE** technical assistance to all small businesses.
